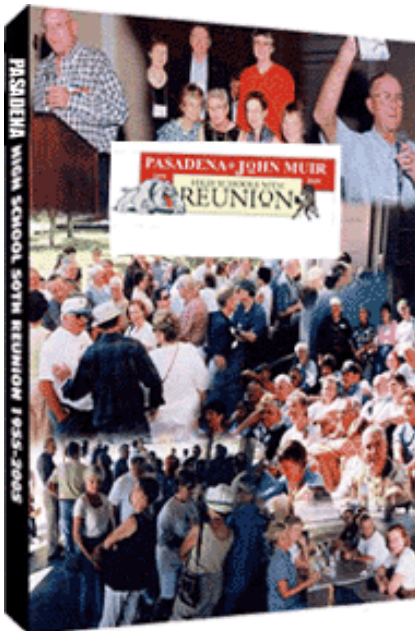


Pasadena High School

Highlights Area Mar '55 As many of us did, I started at PCC in the fall of '53, but graduated from Orange Coast and then Long Beach State in '61. From LBSC I went directly to Navy OCS in Rhode Island. Participated in nuclear tests near Hawaii, then my ship deployed to Japan, Hong Kong, etc. Married Charlotte Wick, an Iowa girl who had been teaching in So. Cal. in '62. Did a tour on an admiral's staff out of Japan, our first taste of living in Asia. Got out of the Navy in '64, lived in Santa Ana Heights, worked in retailing, and then became a public assistance case worker. After taking off from Cal. in '67, we bought a 30-foot gaff-rigged Tahiti Ketch in Massachusetts, cruised the East Coast and Bahamas, then wound up in Miami for five years, with Bahamas cruises interrupted. Son Jonathan was born in '69 while we were living aboard in Coconut Grove. Doing social work and teaching in Liberty City we learned a lot! Started grad school at U. of Florida in '73. 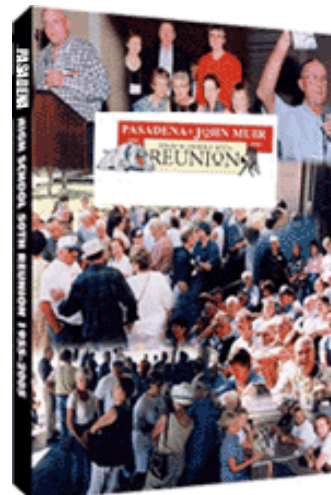
